

Operation Code Vet, Inc. – Private Property Clean-Up: Volunteer Guidelines

All volunteers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.

All volunteers should pre-register with Operation Code Vet's project manager.

WHAT TO DO:

- ✓ Review and follow all rules adopted by Operation Code Vet
- ✓ Complete any safety trainings required by Operation Code Vet
- ✓ Adhere to all safety policies and practices on site
- ✓ Regardless of the scope of the project, each volunteer must only do what is within their respective capabilities, training, and expertise. If any particular task requires specific training or certifications, the volunteer must have such expertise or certification and must provide proof to Operation Code Vet's project manager.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- ✓ Hard-soled and closed-toed shoes
- ✓ Long pants
- ✓ Breathable fabrics, or clothing appropriate to the weather
- ✓ **DO NOT WEAR** dangly jewelry or any clothing which presents a safety hazard

WHAT TO BRING:

- ✓ Gloves
- ✓ Eye Protection
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Bug Spray
- ✓ Hand towels
- ✓ Water
- ✓ Executed volunteer release
- ✓ Any additional items identified by the project manager

We want all of our volunteers to have a great experience helping the veterans in our community. However, failure to comply with the above guidelines may result in removal from the project site and may affect your ability to volunteer for future projects.
